In terms of the CID's MOI, every registered member has one vote for every R5 000 000 (five million) of municipal valuation or portion thereof, but subject to a maximum of ten votes. Furthermore, no member who is in arrears with payment of the additional rate (CID Levy) for

more than 60 days shall be entitled to vote for so long as he / she is in arrears except if the member can prove that he / she is in a dispute or has entered an appropriate payment arrangement with the City. The CID manager has obtained written proof of valuations in respect of all member's present (and proxy forms received) to determine the number of votes per members. The latest CID levy arrears list received from the City of Cape Town has been perused and confirms that there are no members participating in terms of voting who are in arrears of more than 60 days where this has not been paid or proof provided showing that the member is in a dispute or has entered an appropriate payment arrangement with the City.

2.2 Quorum to constitute a meeting -

A quorum is established as more than 20% of the Members are in attendance, inclusive of proxies In accordance with Clause 11.6 of the Memorandum of Incorporation ("MOI"). The meeting was deemed to be duly convened.

3. Previous minutes

Approval minutes of Members meeting (20.02.2019)

The minutes of the General Meeting dated 20 February 2019 are considered read as these were available for download from the CID'S website. Proposed to be correct by Mr J O'Callaghan. This was unanimously accepted by the Members.

The agenda was proposed to be accepted by Mr J O'Callaghan. This was unanimously accepted by all Members present at the meeting.

4. Chairman's Report

Mr. J O'Callaghan provided a brief overview of the year's activities

5. Feedback on operations 2018-19

Mr. J O'Callaghan and Mr J Schwellnus provided a brief overview of the year's activities:

 16 cameras are installed in 8 locations, including LPR cameras at the entrances and a high resolution tracking camera along the jeep track, shared with Bokkemanskloof

- · Access path to the jeep track has been created, secured by locks
- Marilyn Leadsom has initiated extensive clean-ups on the verges and public open spaces around the Overkloof area
- Bins have been positioned and signage put up
- Cleansing contract was put out to tender and won by Bay Garden and Pools
- A fire risk assessment was done, which was presented to the City and Northoaks Estate
 for actioning, as the greatest fire risk to the area poses from the adjourning land owned
 by the City and Northoaks Estate. Both the City and Northoaks took subsequent action,
 which remains in progress.

6. Noting of Audited Financial Statements 2018-19

The audited Annual Financial Statements are available on the CIDs website. Mr O'Callaghan presented a summary of the financial report and stated that Annual Financial Statements had met audit requirements. No questions are raised by Members regarding the audited financial report.

The Annual Financial Statements presented by Mr O'Callaghan were unanimously accepted by the members present at the meeting.

7. Approval of budget 2020-21

The budget for 2020-21 was unanimously accepted by all registered Members present at the meeting

8. Approval of implementation plan 2020-21

The implementation plan for 2020-21 was unanimously accepted by all registered Members present at the meeting

9. Appointment of auditors

The members unanimously agree that the CID continue with the services of Harry Curtis and Co CA(SA)

10 Confirmation of Company secretary - John O'Callaghan - APPROVED

Mr J O'Callaghan was unanimously confirmed as company secretary by the members present at the meeting.

11 Election of Board Members

In accordance with Clause 12.1.7 of the MOI ("as required by item 5(1)(b) of Schedule 1 to the Act, at least 1/3 (one third) of the directors shall resign every year at the AGM, but shall be eligible for re-election"), John O'Callaghan resigned as a director. His re-election as a director was unanimously confirmed by all Members present at the meeting.

No new nominations were received in respect of Directorship on the CID Board Mr. J O'Callaghan thanked all Board members for their services rendered.

13 Q & A

- Paul Pigeguy raised the points of the low water pressure and warned that this poses a risk as it limits the firefighting ability in Overkloof
- Paul Pigeuy raised the point that the two only entrance points to Overkloof were dangerous intersections.
- JO confirmed that both of these points were raised at the previous GM, and had subsequently been escalated to the City, without satisfactory results, mostly due to the lack of viable alternatives.

Suggestions for use of the public open space were called for. It was suggested that OCID would investigate entering into along term lease for the POS with the City, which would allow more possibilities and ringfence the land for purposes in line with the interests of the OCID.

Kennedy O'Brien of BayGardens and Pools warned of dangerous pine trees on the POS. JO advised that this risk had been brought to the attention of the City.

It was discussed if it may be an attractive option to lease a chipper, which could be used to process garden refuse and vegetation on the POS. It was noted that this would require undesirable stockpiling to justify the expense.
